APAN Accelerated BA—MA Program

The accelerated BA/MA Program in Applied Anthropology (APAN) in the Department of Anthropology and Middle Eastern Cultures (AMEC) enables you to early up to **12 hours** of graduate course credit during your final year of Undergraduate studies. Applications may be made during Junior year or upon the completion of at least **60 hours** of undergraduate coursework.

Requirements:

Students must be enrolled in MSU and be a declared Anthropology Major. Students must have completed a minimum of 60 hours of undergraduate coursework. Students must have an overall GPA of 3.5.

Statement of purpose outlining interest in and rationale for pursuing the APAN MA Degree. This should be 1-2 pages in length, single spaced with 12-point type and 1 inch margins

At least two reference letters addressed to the Graduate Coordinator written by individuals familiar with the applicant's academic performance and potential as a graduate student.
